











FOUR FLOWS THAT CONNECT THE WORLD

MOST FLOWS ARE DOMESTIC RATHER THAN INTERNATIONAL










EXPORTS AND IMPORTS BY VALUE OF GOODS AND BY MODE OF TRANSPORTATION






TÜRKİYE 2053 NET ZERO EMISSIONS TARGET

Share of Rail in Freight Transportation








